<p><b>7. Nurse Practitioner</b> Nurse practitioners are nurses with advanced training and experience. This special training allows them to do many of the tasks that doctors usually do.</p>	<b>D</b>
<p><b>8. Concierge</b> Concierges work on the front lines of customer service in the hospitality industry. They make sure that guests and residents are comfortable.</p>	<b>C</b>
<p><b>9. Allergist</b> Allergists are special medical doctors. They diagnose and treat people with allergies to things like peanuts or pollen.</p>	<b>C</b>
<p><b>10. Writer</b> Writers create both literary and factual pieces of writing. That includes books, plays, poems, ads, articles, and manuals.</p>	<b>C</b>

<p><b>21. Critic</b> Critics prepare and present reviews of films, music, food, and more. They share their specialized knowledge and opinions with a wide audience.</p>	C
<p><b>22. Oncologist</b> Oncologists are medical doctors who specialize in diagnosing and treating cancer. They help to combat one of medical science's greatest challenges.</p>	C

<p>37. <b>Anesthesiologist</b>            Anesthesiologists are medical doctors. They use special drugs and gases, called anesthetics, to keep patients pain-free during surgery.</p>	C
<p>38. <b>Neurologist</b>            Neurologists are specialist doctors. They diagnose and treat the disorders that affect our brains and nervous systems.</p>	C
<p>39. <b>Director</b>            Directors are the technical experts who turn scripts into plays, films, or TV shows. They direct the creative team to make sure their vision for a production is fulfilled.</p>	D
